

Permission to form a Thesis Committee for the Honors Program in Art History

To the honors candidate:

The Honors candidate will identify a Project Supervisor with the advice and assistance of the Departmental Honors Advisor and gain that professor's consent. The applicant must have the same Project Supervisor throughout both semesters of the entire project. ***Students seeking Departmental Honors must secure their Project Supervisor's participation prior to starting the Honors Program.***

Once registered for ART 691H, the student will confer with the Project Supervisor and choose two additional members for a committee of three. The Departmental Honors Advisor is notified of the constituency of this committee through the use of this form, submitted to the Student Services Assistant by the due date.

Honors candidates must meet with the Project Supervisor regularly throughout the academic year and will meet with other committee members as needed and determined by the candidate and Project Supervisor.

Stipulations:

- Students must choose an **art history faculty member** to be the Project Supervisor. This faculty member must be in residence for BOTH semesters of the student's honors study.
- A second faculty must be Art Department faculty.
- A third member must be a UNC faculty member but may be from another department. Consider faculty who might bring another perspective to your research interests.
